Phelps County Proposition A, Use Tax,

Shall Phelps County impose a local use tax at the same rate as the county sales tax rate, currently 1.125%.

If approved, this measure would impose a use tax for out-of-state purchases of tangible personal property delivered to Phelps County for use, storage, or consumption, where the same items would be subject to sales tax if purchased locally.

Pursuant to Section 144.757 RSMo, and the voter-approved ballot of April 7, 1981, the use tax shall be subject to the same reduction of real property tax as the local sales tax to ensure compliance with statutory requirements.

Revenue generated from the use tax will be dedicated to the improvement and repair of Phelps County roads and infrastructure, this additional Revenue will not subrogate the general fund contribution to the Road and Bridge Department.

The use tax is not an additional tax but ensures that out-of-state purchases are taxed at the same rate as local purchases, preventing the loss of local tax revenue.
